The regular meeting of the Logan East Rural Water System Advisory Committee was called to order by Ron Dierking Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Monday January 9, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. in the Logan East Rural Water System Office Oakland, Nebraska. The Publication of Meeting Notice was printed in the Oakland Independent newspaper on Jan 5, 2023.

The Nebraska Open Meeting Act information is posted by the entrance door.

Roll call was taken with 9 of the 9 committee members present. Present: Dam, Dierking, Fehrer, Hagerbaumer, Johnson, Kruger, Lydick, Scheer, and Wulf. Absent: none Roll call of Lower Elkhorn NRD appointed members. Present: Gary Loftis & Roger Gustafson.

Scheer made the motion & was seconded by Hagerbaumer to <u>adopt the agenda</u>.. Aye: All. Nay: none. Absent:. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Minutes of the December 12, 2022 meeting were approved Aye: All. Nay: none. Absent: none

Roger Fehrer, Don Johnson, Larry Wulf have agreed to serve and additional 3 year term on the Logan East Rural Water System Advisory Committee.

Kruger made the motion and was seconded by Fehrer to recommend to the LERND <u>the officers of the Logan</u> East Rural Water System Advisory Committee remain the same for the year 2023. Ron Dierking, chairman, Larry Wulf vice-chairman with Laurie Schold secretary. Aye: All. Nay: none. Absent: **MOTION CARRIED.**

Income & expenses were reviewed, 23 people still owe for November water.

Item #8 on the agenda is concerning fire hydrant use. Fire Departments need to notify LERWS when using water out of fire hydrants on this system. LERWS need to start the well pumps to help keep towers full in this type of situation. Dam suggested holding a meeting with fire chiefs within the system, explaining the stipulations on the fire hydrant use.

Well #3 rehab project: Blahak reported Sargent is waiting for a flow meter. Work has been postponed until March 2023. Wulf asked if the pump will remain the same or if this well be converted to a submersible pump. Dierking said the existing pump will continue to be used.

The search for a new well location has not progressed during the past month. Sue Lackey-geologist will continue to study mapping. It is recommended that locations west of the Logan Creek be considered because of water quality. Nitrate levels were discussed, Lydick asked about the action plan if the level goes above the legal limit.

Blahak gave the managers' report (see attached copy). A fire near Talabasta, leak in the Village of Uehling, and a broken pipe at Rhea Cattle all contributed to a problem keeping the Fontanelle tower full on Christmas Day.

Dam asked about the \$5,000 LENRD grant for the well search. It has been received and will be on the financial reports at the Feb meeting.

The next meeting will be February 13, 2023 at the LERWS office in Oakland at 7:00 p.m.

Being no further business. Dierking adjourned the meeting at 8:00 p.m.
