The regular meeting of the Logan East Rural Water System Advisory Committee was called to order by Ron Dierking-Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Monday June 12, 2023 at 8:00 p.m. in the Logan East Rural Water System Office Oakland, Nebraska. The Publication of Meeting Notice was printed in the Oakland Independent newspaper on June 1,,2023.

Roll call was taken with 8 of the 9 committee members present. Present: Dam, Dierking, Fehrer Johnson, Hagerbaumer, Kruger Scheer, and Wulf. Absent: Lydick.. Roll call of Lower Elkhorn NRD appointed members. Present: Roger Gustafson Absent: Gary Loftis Brian Bruckner, LENRD Interimmanager was also in attendance.

Fehrer made the motion & was seconded by Scheer to <u>adopt the agenda</u>. Aye: All. Nay: none. Absent:Lydick. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Income & expense reports where given. 12 customers still owe for April water. All disconnection letters have paid. A first look at the Fiscal Year 2024 budget was done.

Agenda item #6 generator yearly service agreement was discussed and tabled until the July meeting. Blahak needs to get more information on the hours the generator has been used and if the contract can be changed to one service visit per year and contract price locked in for extended years.

Fehrer made the motion and was seconded by Kruger The property at 327 CR 23 Hooper Twp: 20 Rg:8 Sec:14 previously owned by Roger Bray can be reconnected for the \$2,000, as stated in the LERWS rules & regulations book on page 9. Aye: Dam, Dierking, Fehrer, Kruger, Johnson, Scheer, and Wulf. Abstained: Hagerbaumer Absent: Lydick. **MOTION CARRIED**

Wulf made the motion and was seconded by Kruger to <u>ratify a new service for Keith & Lois Krohn</u> 25447 Cr 4 Herman Twp: 20 Rg: 9 Sec: 34 for the \$3,500. Hook up fee. Aye: Dam, Dierking, Fehrer, Hagerbaumer, Kruger, Johnson, Scheer, and Wulf. Absent: Lydick. **MOTION CARRIED**

Fehrer made the motion and was seconded by Hagerbaumer to <u>purchase four Cooper brand tires from 2nd Street Station in the amount of \$,1,467.61 as per quote, for the 2021 LERWS pickup. Dam asked about the possible line extension discussed at the May 2023 meeting. It was for 4,000 feet of 3"pipe line extended in Twp: 23 Rg:10 Sec 08 along Burt County road 25 that could add an

additional 4 possible hook ups to LERWS. This would also help increase pressure to customers east of county road 27. Blahak reported the home owners in the area are not interested.

New well search: The agreement with Roy & Sarah Miller for a possible well site will need to be signed by both Millers- land owners and Brian Bruckner, interim LENRD mgr. Sargent Irrigation is scheduled to dig the test well the week of June 19th, 2023. Susan Lackey NU geologist will be present during the dig.

Scott Lindstrom would like the test well sealed that is on his property. Sargent Irrigation will do the work for \$3,000 when they are in the area doing the test well on Millers. LENRD cost share on decommissioned wells will be checked on.

Blahak gave the managers' report (see attached copy).

Wulf asked about the Micro Comm results and recommendations after their site visit. Blahak said needing to turn the antenna at the Oakland tower is the only information received as of date.

The next meeting will be July 10, 2023 at the LERWS office in Oakland at 8:00 p.m.

Being no further business Dierking adjourned the meeting at 9:30p.m..
