MINUTES OF REGULAR LOGAN EAST RURAL WATER SYSTEM ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING 8:00 p.m. September 11, 2023 Monday LOGAN EAST RURAL WATER SYSTEM OFFICE – OAKLAND. NE

The regular meeting of the Logan East Rural Water System Advisory Committee was called to order by Ron Dierking-Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Monday September 11, 2023 at 8:00 p.m. in the Logan East Rural Water System Office Oakland, Nebraska. The Publication of Meeting Notice was printed in the Oakland Independent newspaper on Sept 7, 2023. The Nebraska Open Meeting Act information is posted by the entrance door.

Roll call was taken with 7 of the 9 committee members present. Present: Dierking, Dam, Fehrer, Hagerbaumer, Johnson, Kruger, and Wulf. Absent: Scheer, & Lydick. Roll call of Lower Elkhorn NRD appointed members. Present: Gary Loftis Absent: Roger Gustafson. Also present: Brian Bruckner, LENRD Interim manager.

Fehrer made the motion & was seconded by Kruger to <u>adopt the agenda</u>. Aye: All. Nay: none. Absent: Lydick & Scheer. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Minutes of the August 14, 2023 meeting were read. Fehrer made the motion and was seconded by Kruger to approve the minutes. Aye: All. Nay: none. Absent: Lydick & Scheer. **MOTION CARRIED**

Income & expense reports where given. 14 customers still owe for July water. 2 disconnections will be made if not paid tomorrow.

Fehrer made the motion and was seconded by Kruger the Logan East Rural Water System user agreement section #2 has the addition of "If a line extension is needed to reach the new subscriber\s meter point, the cost of the extension will be paid by the new subscribers. The line extension will become the IPA's ownership and responsibility after installation is completed." (See complete user agreement attached to these minutes). Aye: Dierking, Dam, Fehrer, Hagerbaumer, Johnson, Kruger, and Wulf. Absent: Scheer, & Lydick. MOTION CARRIED

Agenda Item#7 Blahak explained a 2 ½" line along Burt County Road C in Twp:20 Rg: 10 Sec 10 was moved and lowered Sept 12, 2023 because land owner Greg Brummond has removed dirt from around the water line. Approximately 600 feet of line was moved & the LERWS acct 509 service was re-tapped. All expenses will be paid by Brummond, Logan East Rural Water System will retain ownership of the line.

The Scada Communication Company, Micro Comm, has sent estimates for improvements on LERWS telemetry. After looking at four options, Wulf made the motion and was seconded by Hagerbaumer to approve the yellow quote #MCQ23048 for CTU upgrade and antenna/co ax at a negotiable price not to exceed \$23,761.00 (see attached copy) Aye: Dam, Dierking, Fehrer, Hagerbaumer, Johnson, Kruger, and Wulf. Absent: Lydick, & Scheer, MOTION CARRIED.

New well search:

The Roy Miller test well was again pumped with samples taken and sent to Midwest Lab, Water Science Lab-UNL, and NE state lab.

These test results also do not meet specifications for grant funding for the Village of Craig. Next step options will be discussed with Sue Lackey-NU geologist and John Ruckman-Bartlett & West. Some of the things to be considered are drilling a smaller diameter test well not as deep on the Miller site, cost of a treatment plant for nitrate vs manganese, tapping into the same aquafer as current LERWS wells, or looking at irrigation samples taken earlier this year on K. Anderson ground.

Blahak gave the managers' report (see attached copy).

LERWS has had another leak along Dodge county road C east of the Scribner booster pump. This item is continued from the August meeting. Approximate measurements of 3,000 feet length, but no price estimates were presented for the committee to look at for replacing part of that 8" water main.

The next meeting will be October 9, 2023 at the LERWS office in Oakland at 8:00 p.m.

Being no further business Dierking adjourned the meeting at 9:30 p.m.
