Replacing an 8"water main along County Road C in Dodge county-east of the Scribner booster pump was again discussed. Blakah has contacted several local companies. There is question on the need for engineering based on the total dollar amount of the project. There is a possibility of slowing the clay valve down in the Scribner booster station seeing if that could help the pressures. Blahak will make some changes to the clay-valve timing and report at the next meeting.

The upgrading of the scada communication by Micro Comm antennas and wiring at the towers and booster pumps has been completed.

The in-office upgrades will be completed possibly in December. Blahak will check the completion date on the contract.

New well search: Blahak has taken water samples off of two irrigation wells and has several more lined up to completed yet this fall.. Bruckner showed the committee a map with the current well head protection that was developed in 1999. Possible changes and upgrades will be recommended to the LENRD. A plan will be submitted to Steve McNulty at Nebraska Department of Environment and Energy by spring.

Blahak gave the managers' report (see attached copy).
