The regular meeting of the Logan East Rural Water System Advisory Committee was called to order by Ron Dierking-Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Monday December 11, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. in the Logan East Rural Water System Office Oakland, Nebraska. The Publication of Meeting Notice was printed in the Oakland Independent newspaper on December 7, 2023.

The Nebraska Open Meeting Act information is posted by the entrance door.

Roll call was taken with 7 of the 9 committee members present. Present: Dierking, Dam, Fehrer, Hagerbaumer, Johnson, Kruger, and Lydick, Absent: Scheer & Wulf. Roll call of Lower Elkhorn NRD appointed members. Present: Gary Loftis Absent: Roger Gustafson. Also present: Brian Bruckner, LENRD manager.

Fehrer made the motion & was seconded by Hagerbaumer to <u>adopt the agenda</u>. Aye: All. Nay: none. Absent: Scheer & Wulf. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Minutes of the November 13, 2023 meeting were read. Fehrer made the motion and was seconded by Hagerbaumer to approve the minutes. Aye: All. Nay: none. Absent: Scheer & Wulf. **MOTION CARRIED**

Income & expense reports where given. 21 customers still owe for October water. All customers receiving disconnect letters have responded

The current LERWS hook up fee for a new water service is \$3,500. Discussion was held on costs and the committee feels it's time to increase the fee that has been in effect since 2011.

Dam made a motion and was seconded by Lydick to recommend to the LENRD an increase in the Logan East Rural Water System hook up fee making it \$4,000. Starting January 1, 2024. Aye: Dierking, Dam, Fehrer, Hagerbaumer, Johnson, Kruger, Lydick, Absent: Scheer and Wulf. MOTION CARRIED

The 8"water main along County Road C in Dodge county-east of the Scribner booster pump was again discussed. Blahak adjusted the pressures on 12-11-2023. He will watch the gauges in the next few weeks and readjust as needed. Blahak & Johansen have also noticed water at the base of the Scribner tower. They will continue to watch to determine if there is a leak in the line to the tower or if it's a landscaping problem. Employees also reported new additional rock needs to be added at other LERWS sites.

New well search: The irrigation wells tested on the Johnson & Wesley farms have results that are within some of the qualifying limits. Landowners will be contacted to see if possible test wells could be drilled. Discussion was held on renting the one acre plot on the Roy Miller test well site. No action was taken, it will be tabled until the January 2024 meeting.

Blahak gave the managers' report (see attached copy).

The next meeting will be January 8, 2024 at the LERWS office in Oakland at 7:00 p.m.

Being no further business Dierking adjourned the meeting at 8:20 p.m.
