### LOWER ELKHORN NATURAL RESOURCES DISTRICT RESOLUTION SETTING THE PROPERTY TAX REQUEST

WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1632 provides that the Governing Body of the Lower Elkhorn Natural Resources District passes by a majority vote a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request; and

WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governing Body of the Lower Elkhorn Natural Resources District, resolves that:

- 1. The 2024 2025 property tax request be set at \$4,501,887.14.
- 2. The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 12.49%.
- 3. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property, would be \$0.020079 per \$100 of assessed value.
- 4. The Lower Elkhorn Natural Resources District proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be \$0.018459 per \$100 of assessed value.
- 5. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, that total operating budget of the Lower Elkhorn Natural Resources District will increase from last years by 6.42%.
- 6. A copy of this resolution will be certified and forwarded to the County Clerk on or before October 15, 2024.
