Motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Shelton to keep the 2016 allocation limits equal to the 2015 limits, which are: 18 acre-inches per irrigated acre for gravity/flood irrigation systems, 13 acre-inches per irrigated acre for subsurface drip irrigation systems, and 14 acre-inches per irrigated acre for all other irrigation systems in the Eastern Madison County Quantity Subarea; and 17 acre-inches per irrigated acre for gravity/flood irrigation systems, 12 acre-inches per irrigated acre for subsurface drip irrigation systems, and 13 acre-inches per irrigated acre for all other irrigation systems in the Wayne County Quantity Subarea. applications of 10 acres or less if the addition of the requested acres will allow the applicant's center pivot irrigation system to finish its circle and to allow for the approval of qualified good cause variances and, to approve a total of no more than 250 new irrigated acres in the hydrologically connected area and no more than 250 irrigated acres in the non-hydrologically connected area for applications located outside of the District's quantity subareas for 2016. In addition, the Board directs the staff to develop a policy to allow for the approval of supplemental wells, only in situations where the certified irrigated acres have been severed from the source of groundwater.
