Whitney Gappa reported on the Bazile Groundwater Management Area. A report is attached to the official minutes.

A presentation was given by Dr. Chittaranjan Ray, Professor and Director of the Nebraska Water Center and Michael Kaiser, Assistant Professor of Soil and Water Sciences. The pair discussed many soil chemistry concepts and answered questions.

Motion was made by Gustafson and seconded by Loftis <u>to accept the Logan East Rural Water System Advisory Committee minutes of June 14, 2021</u>. Connor Baldwin, Groundwater Management Area Specialist, reported that all Annual Reports for Phase 2 and 3 in Pierce and Madison Counties have been turned in.

Motion was made by Allemann and seconded by Korth to reject all bids for the Willow Creek Dam Pore Pressure Mitigation – Phase 1 Project and to authorize the General Manager to sign a contract with Dietz Well for completion of 2 test holes and two production wells at Willow Creek Dam not to exceed \$92,240.00. Motion was made by Steffen and seconded by Loftis to accept the proposal from the University of Nebraska to conduct certain research related to Characterization of Groundwater Nitrate using Stable Isotope Analysis in the Lower Elkhorn Natural Resources District and to authorize the General Manager to sign the project agreement, not to exceed \$17,712.00, on behalf of the District.
