Motion was made by Gustafson and seconded by Clausen to approve the Logan East Rural Water System recommendation to update the SCADA system at a total cost, not to exceed \$78,569.00, over a period of 5 years. Motion was made by Reikofski and seconded by Alleman <u>to provide financial assistance to</u> <u>the Northeast Nebraska Weed Management Area, not to exceed \$6,000.00 annually, for FY26, FY27, and FY28, to be used as matching funds for a 3-year grant from the Nebraska Environmental Trust (NET). Extension of the \$6,000.00 is contingent on successful procurement</u>

of the NET grant and will only be expended on lands within the Lower Elkhorn Natural Resources District.

Discussion followed.

Motion was made by Klein and seconded by Korth to amend the original motion to read - <u>to provide financial assistance to all counties in the LENRD District</u>, not to exceed \$6,000.00 annually, for FY26, FY27, and FY28, to be used as matching funds for a 3-year grant from the <u>Nebraska Environmental Trust (NET)</u>. Extension of the \$6,000.00 is contingent on successful procurement of the <u>NET grant and will only be expended on lands within the Lower Elkhorn Natural Resources District</u>. Aye: Klein, Korth.
